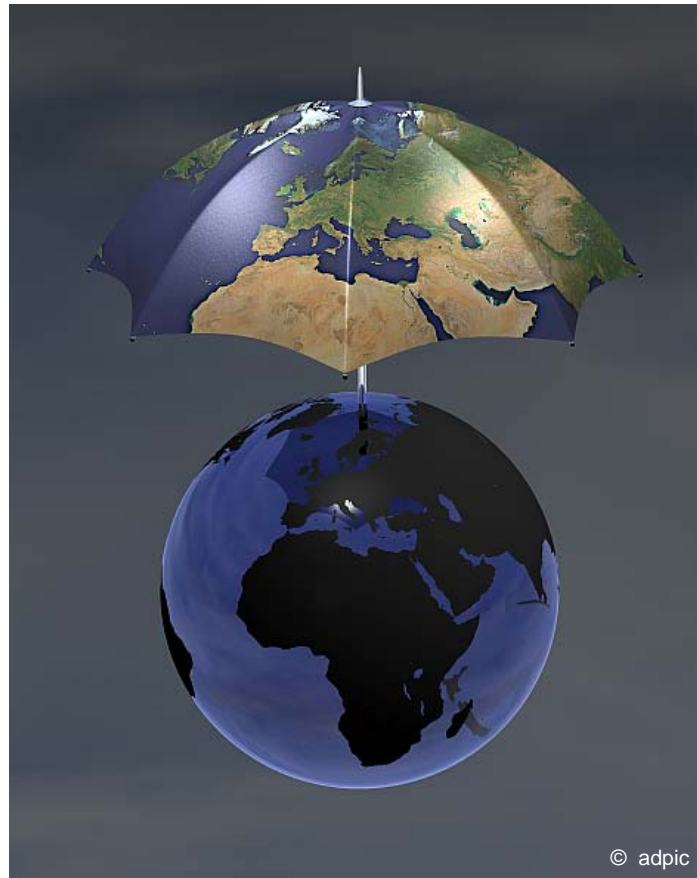

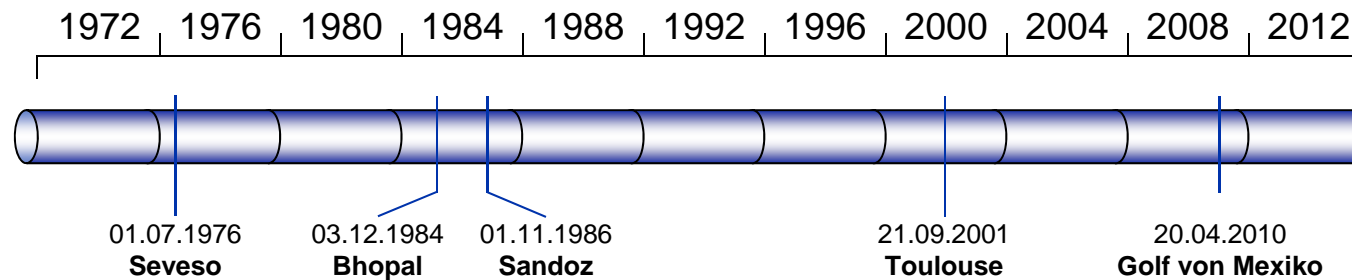

WSSD 2002 in Johannesburg

A major focus of the international community

- By 2010 reduce biodiversity loss.
- By 2015 reduce number of people living in extreme poverty (income less than 1 \$/d) by 500 m, primary schooling worldwide for all children, halve the proportion of people without basic sanitation.
- By 2020 minimise significant adverse effects to human health and the environment during production and use of chemicals.

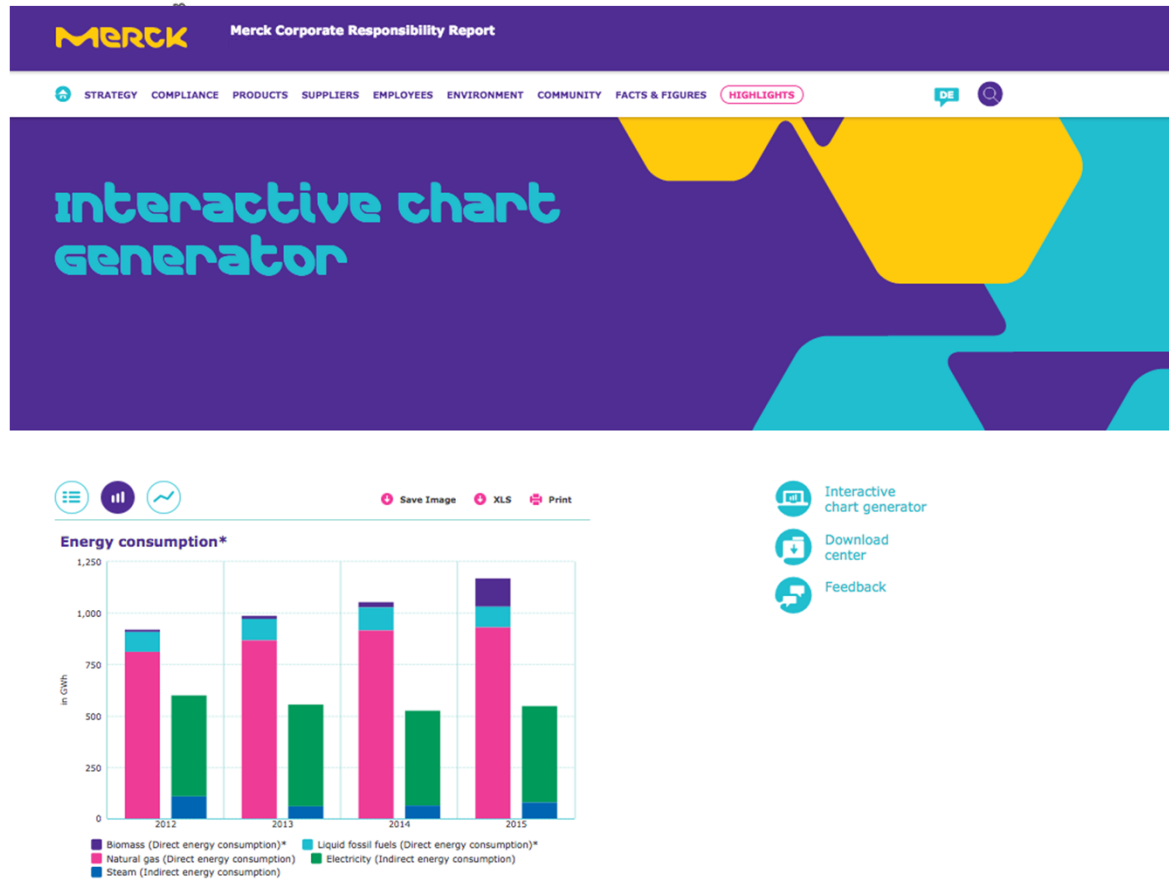
Reaktion der Europäischen Union

Strategic Elements

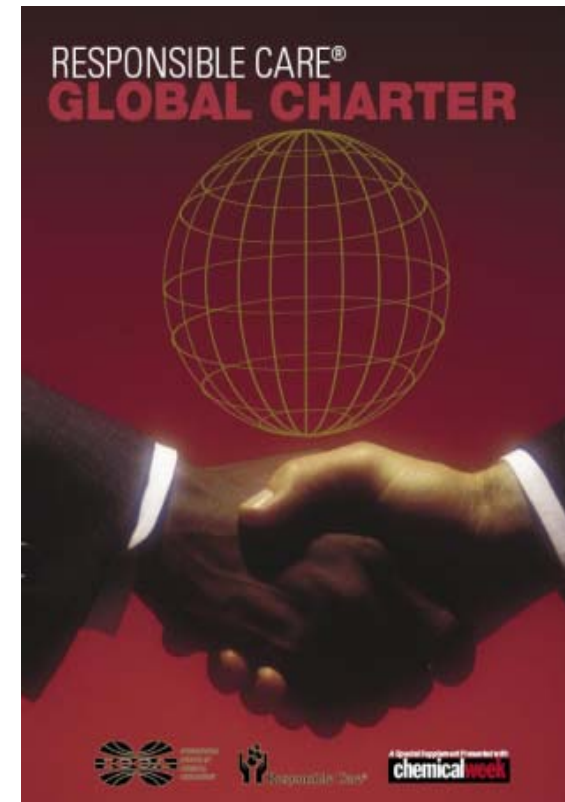
Product stewardship, risk approach, partnership with NGOs, public information, global advocacy
